As I have heard nothing since I sent my e-mail to Richard Mc Craith on February 5th I was just writing to ask whether there was any possibility of the Parish Council writing a letter of support in respect of our project to restore seven chest tombs in the Churchyard.

We are about to submit our application to the Heritage Lottery Fund in the next week or so and we are advised to enclose letters of support for the project from interested parties. A letter from the Parish Council would be ideal and I wrote in my earlier e-mail a suggestion of what could be included in the letter:

- 1. The unsightly wire cages around the chest tombs the cages have now been in place for four years. No action has been taken and the condition of the tombs can only deteriorate further.
- 2. Pleased to support the formation of a voluntary committee under the auspices of the Parochial Church Council to explore ways in which the tombs could be restored. In order to initiate a local fundraising campaign in April 2018 LAPC was the first body to donate £200 to which sum a further £1,100 was contributed by donations from private individuals making a total of £1,300.
- 3. The Council is willing to support the activities (as in the attached report) planned by the Committee to highlight the rich heritage of Luckington to the community.

I would be so very grateful if you could look into this matter.
