Dear Parish Council

Since you have invited comments about a proposed Village Green Path:

I think the green looks good without a path and I don't think it is necessary.

Instead, why not put a path next to the Green alongside the main road opposite the school between the roadside kerb and Green where the bus stops opposite the bus shelter. Wiltshire Council might be able to assist with the cost of this Safety Measure which would provide a path to walk along to the bus stopping point opposite the bus shelter and a safe point to cross the busy road to the school.

I hope you will give this alternative option your consideration as I think it is a much better solution than a path going across the Green.

I must also comment (as an ex-town dweller of course!) that we do seem to be rather lacking in proper footpaths alongside the roads here in Luckington and it would be safer to have a footpath alongside the road to walk to the pub and shop as well.

Open textures such as those in the pictures will allow weeds and grass to grow over. I originally had stepping stone slabs on my back lawn to give access to the rotary clothes line. These have now completely disappeared beneath the turf!
