Later in the year, we welcomed two new people, Sam Evans and Robert Simpkins who has been on the Parish Council before. Thank you very much for joining.

Our finances have remained health and we have approximately 14,000 in our accounts after the year end. We increased the precept by 1% for 2018/19.

Planning during the year, we have an ongoing plan from Badminton Estate in Alderton to alter New Farm into 7 dwellings. This, I am sure, will run on this year but they have put in planning permission this month.

We had an application for a change of use of some land and a house with solar panels to be built also in Alderton and this was in the end turned down.

I would very much like to help the local community more but we did donate approximately £700 to various projects from FOLS to others.

We are also going to pay for any ongoing costs with the defibrillator in Luckington.

We have the churchyard in the village which needs repair and would very much like to help. (SLM) has kindly volunteered to keep us informed of the ongoing project.

We continue to look after grass cutting and the cemetery where we had some repairs to the wall.

I would like to thank all the Councillors for their time and hard work.

Also I would like to thank Tim Guard for sending out communications on behalf of the Parish Council.
